

## **WEGMANS FACILITIES GROUP RULES FOR CONTRACTORS**

The following general rules for Contractors, their Subcontractors, and their Employees while on Wegmans Market Street premises.

### **1. SUPERVISION AND CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURES**

- 1.1 Contractor shall supervise and direct the Work using its best skill and attention. It shall be solely responsible for all construction means, methods, techniques, sequences and procedures for Work done by its forces and those under its direction or control, for coordinating all portions of the Work under the Contract, and for safety as well as conformity and timeliness of all portions of the Work under the Contract.
- 1.2 Contractor shall coordinate all of its own Work with any work performed under other contracts in the manner directed by Wegmans and in accordance with the Project Schedule. This shall include coordination of device location, cutting and patching, work schedules, etc. Contractor shall make every effort to minimize disruption and expedite the Work through close coordination and cooperation with Wegmans and the separate contractors.
- 1.3 Contractor shall be responsible to Wegmans for the acts and omissions of its employees, Subcontractors and their agents and employees, and other persons directly or indirectly performing any of the Work product. All expense caused by correction of Work improperly performed or the use of improper product, as well as all expense due to untimely or improperly coordinated Work, shall be the responsibility of Contractor.
- 1.4 Where equipment lines, piping and conduit are shown diagrammatically, Contractor shall be responsible for the coordination and orderly arrangement of the various lines of exposed piping and conduit included in the Work. It shall coordinate the Work of his Subcontractors and prevent all interference's between equipment, lines of piping, and architectural features, and avoid any unsightly arrangements in the exposed Work.
- 1.5 Contractor, its employees, Subcontractors, suppliers, representatives, invitees and agents will be subject to such rules and regulations for the conduct of Work as Wegmans may establish. Contractor will be responsible for the enforcement of Wegmans' instructions among its employees.
- 1.6 Wegmans may direct Contractor to remove from the site any employee of Contractor or any Subcontractor, supplier, representative, invitee or agent who Wegmans believes is intoxicated or under the influence of any illegal drug or alcohol, or who is insubordinate, destructive of property, engaged in fighting or horseplay, or who is otherwise disruptive to the orderly conduct of the Work or the business operations of Wegmans Food Markets.
- 1.7 Neither Contractor nor any Subcontractor nor any other person employed at the site shall sell, use, possess, permit or suffer intoxicating drink or illegal drugs upon or about the site, nor shall Contractor or any Subcontractor permit the use of radios, CD players or tape players.
- 1.8 Contractor shall be responsible for harmony among its own employees, agents and Subcontractors and those of other contractors performing work under other contracts.

### **2. USE OF SITE**

- 2.1 Contractor shall confine operations at the site to areas specifically designated by Wegmans and shall not unreasonably encumber the site with any materials. Contractor agrees to store materials only within the areas designated by the Wegmans and will do so in such a way as not to interfere with or delay ongoing activities near the site. If, in the reasonable opinion of Wegmans, job conditions require accessibility to any area occupied by Contractor's materials or facilities, they shall be moved at once by Contractor at Contractor's expense to an area approved by Wegmans.
- 2.2 Arrangements for parking of Contractor's personnel and delivery vehicles shall be made with Wegmans Asset Protection. Wegmans Asset Protection will designate areas for unloading or storage or loading of materials.
- 2.3 Wegmans Asset Protection will designate access to the site and will define limits within which Contractor shall control movements of his personnel. Contractor shall ascertain these exact limits prior to starting Work, and shall be responsible for all consequences resulting from failure to either determine or observe such limits. Except as specifically authorized in writing by Wegmans, or as specifically indicated in the Contract Documents, all access shall be via existing paved road or other ways. No construction materials, debris or equipment shall be stored or allowed to accumulate on or adjacent to access ways. All disturbance to access ways and related areas or facilities resulting from Contractor's use shall be repaired at Contractor's expense and as approved by Wegmans.
- 2.4 On site material storage areas, if available, will be designated by Wegmans. The availability of adequate, secure interior storage space cannot be guaranteed.
- 2.5 Security of all products, tools or equipment wherever stored or installed shall be the responsibility of Contractor, who shall provide such temporary locks and gang boxes, as he may deem necessary for the security of his goods, and those of his Subcontractors. All such security arrangements are subject to the advance approval of the Wegmans. Where exterior storage is authorized, Contractor shall be solely responsible for suitable protection of the stored goods. Both location and design of such facilities are subject to the approval of Wegmans in advance. Such facilities shall be kept clean and orderly at all times.
- 2.6 Except as otherwise provided, Contractor shall furnish, erect and maintain all staging and scaffolding required for the Work. Staging and scaffolding shall be erected and removed by experienced staging builders and shall have the accident prevention devices required by State, Local and Federal laws.
- 2.7 Contractor shall furnish and maintain all temporary ladders, ramps, runways, chutes, derricks, stairs, hoists, cranes and similar items required for the proper execution of the Work of the Contract, including the work of Subcontractors. Any and all of these facilities shall be constructed so as to prevent damage to, including staining or marring of, permanent Work. All damage resulting from the use of such facilities shall be repaired by Contractor at its expense.
- 2.8 Contractor shall receive prior approval of Wegmans for all use of existing interior access ways. During such permitted use Contractor shall fully protect all surfaces and product from damage, and shall restore all facilities to at least the quality of as-found conditions at the conclusion of the Work.

### **3. CUTTING AND PATCHING OF WORK**

- 3.1 Contractor shall be responsible for all cutting, fitting or patching that may be required to: (a) complete the Work (b) to make its several parts fit together properly; and (c) to finish the Work after installation of the applicable product. Contractor shall be responsible for all cutting

and patching, and shall coordinate the cutting and patching for all trades. Cutting shall be minimized by coordination of the Work.

- 3.2 Contractor shall not damage or endanger any portion of the Work or the work or property of Wegmans or any separate contractors by cutting, patching or otherwise altering any work, or by excavation. Contractor shall not cut or otherwise alter the work of Wegmans or any separate contractor except with the written consent of the Wegmans and of such separate contractor. Contractor shall not unreasonably withhold its consent to cutting or otherwise altering the Work from Wegmans or any separate contractor.

#### **4. CLEANING UP**

- 4.1 Contractor at all times shall keep the premises free from accumulation of waste materials or rubbish caused by its or its Subcontractors' operations. In the event such rubbish or waste materials interfere with Wegmans or separate contractors' operations at any time, Contractor shall remove such waste materials and rubbish daily. At the completion of the Work it shall remove all its waste materials and rubbish from and about the Project as well as all its tools, construction equipment, scaffolding, temporary structures, machinery and surplus materials and other product. Contractor shall clean all glass surfaces and leave floors and benches, etc., "wet-mop clean" or its equivalent as determined by the Wegmans, except as otherwise specified. Grounds shall be swept and raked, and all marks due to the project eradicated.
- 4.2 Contractor shall collect and remove from the site of the Project all waste material and rubbish resulting from the Work. Wegmans may, upon request of Contractor, provide and maintain rubbish containers of appropriate size for its use, but Contractor shall be responsible to assure that these shall be kept free from noxious or hazardous materials and maintained in a neat and orderly fashion.
- 4.3 If Contractor fails to perform or complete cleanup as required hereunder, Wegmans may do so and the cost thereof shall be charged to Contractor as an assessment against Contractor's next Application for Payment.

#### **5. FACILITIES AND SERVICES**

- 5.1 All requirements for temporary electrical power, detailed as to ampacity, phase, voltage, frequency, etc., shall be submitted to Wegmans who will determine and advise Contractor of a source and of any restrictions which Wegmans may place upon its use. Access by Wegmans to its facilities for temporary electrical power is not assured.
- 5.2 Contractor shall install and maintain a telephone on the job site when requested by Wegmans. Contractor shall promptly inform the Wegmans of his telephone number. The superintendent shall at all times be equipped with an operating telephone pager or cellular telephone. Contractor shall inform Wegmans, and all persons directly connected with the Project, of the method for contacting this pager or telephone.
- 5.3 Contractor shall be responsible for all of his own temporary heat and lighting.
- 5.4 Wegmans may, upon request, designate specific existing and temporary sanitary facilities for the use of Contractor and Subcontractors.
- 5.5 Where the Work is primarily exterior to existing structures, or where existing sanitary facilities will not be continuously available throughout the Project, or where required by Wegmans, Contractor shall provide portable sanitary facilities in quantities adequate for the use of its

employees and those of its Subcontractors. Siting and number of these facilities shall be approved in advance by Wegmans.

- 5.6 Wegmans will, upon request, designate a specific source of water. No other water location on the job site may be used.

## **6. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND PROGRAMS**

- 6.1 The Contractor shall be responsible for initiating, maintaining and supervising all safety precautions and programs in connection with the work he performs while on Wegmans property or otherwise associated with the work being performed at Wegmans.
- 6.2 Contractor shall furnish any and all required Personal Protective Equipment to his employees, including head, eye and hearing protection, at no cost to Wegmans. Wegmans will not furnish any such protection (such as safety glasses and ear plugs) to Contractor employees. Unless prior written approval has been obtained from Wegmans, Contractor employees are required to wear hard hats, protective eyewear, long-sleeved work shirts or coats, long pants or coveralls, and steel-toed work boots whenever they are engaged in performing the Work. When the Work is performed in areas of the facilities where hearing protection is required by Wegmans rules, Contractor shall furnish his employees with appropriate hearing protection.
- 6.3 Prior to commencement of any work, the Contractor shall initiate and be responsible for developing a comprehensive written safety program for its employees and those of his Subcontractors. The Contractor must submit a written summary of this program to Wegmans prior to commencement of any work, and will furnish the entire written program to Wegmans representatives if requested.
- 6.4 Prior to commencement of his work, the Contractor shall submit the names, business addresses and phone numbers of those persons employed by the Contractor as responsible for job safety monitoring and safety training in connection with the work performed at Wegmans.

## **7. SAFETY OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY**

- 7.1 The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions for the safety of, and shall provide all necessary protection to prevent damage, injury or loss to: (a) all employees on the Work and all other persons who may be affected thereby; (b) all the Work and all product to be incorporated therein, whether in storage on or off the site; (c) other property at the site or adjacent thereto, including trees, shrubs, lawns, walks, pavements, roadways, structures and utilities not designated for removal, relocation or replacement in the course of construction; and (d) the work of Wegmans or other separate contractors.
- 7.2 Contractor shall give all notices and comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and lawful orders of any public authority bearing on the safety of persons or property or their protection from damage, injury or loss.
- 7.3 Contractor shall erect and maintain, as required by existing conditions and progress of the Work, all reasonable safeguards for safety and protection, including posting danger signs and other warnings against hazards, promulgating safety regulations and notifying Wegmans and users of adjacent utilities.
- 7.4 When the use or storage of toxic or hazardous materials or equipment is necessary for the execution of the Work, Contractor shall exercise the utmost care and shall carry on such activities under the supervision of properly qualified personnel. Contractor shall advise Wegmans in writing and shall furnish Material Safety and Data Sheets whenever hazardous

materials of any type are brought onto Wegmans property. No hazardous materials are to be stored inside of, or on the roofs of, any Wegmans buildings without written permission from Wegmans Asset Protection.

- 7.5 If Contractor fails to take immediate corrective action following oral or written notice from Wegmans of any unsafe condition, unsafe work practice, or deficiency in the Work, Wegmans shall be entitled to take all reasonable corrective action without prior notice and at Contractor's expense.
- 7.6 Contractor shall not load or permit any part of the Work to be loaded so as to endanger its safety.
- 7.7 Contractor shall save Wegmans harmless from all claims arising from the use of any private or public street, sidewalks, and adjoining premises for construction purposes.
- 7.8 Only signs pertaining to safety may be displayed on Wegmans premises.

## **8. EMERGENCIES**

- 8.1 In any emergency affecting the safety of persons or property, Contractor shall act, at its discretion, to prevent threatened damage, injury or loss.
- 8.2 Contractor must furnish to Wegmans a written Emergency Action Plan as required by OSHA 1926.35 which is specific to the Work. Contractor must also advise Wegmans in writing of any changes to his Plan during the course of the Work, and shall invite the appropriate representatives of Wegmans Asset Protection to witness at least one Plan practice drill prior to commencement of the Work.
- 8.3 Contractor shall train each of his employees in their individual responsibilities under Wegmans site emergency plans, and shall certify in writing that all employees and Subcontractor employees were appropriately trained in those responsibilities and successfully demonstrated their understanding of their training.

## **9. FIRE PROTECTION**

- 9.1 Gasoline and other flammable liquids shall be stored in and dispensed from U.L. listed safety containers in conformance with the National Board of Fire Underwriters recommendations. Storage locations shall be approved in advance by the Wegmans.
- 9.2 Fire shall not be started on the job site for any purpose, including work operations, heating or smoking, until the location and conditions of use are approved by Wegmans. Incineration is prohibited.
- 9.3 Contractor must furnish Wegmans with a current copy of their written safety plan which addresses the concerns of OSHA 1926 Subpart J (Hot Work) prior to commencing any cutting, welding, or similar operations where Hot Work may be a safety concern. In addition, Contractor shall obtain a copy of Wegmans Hot Work Permit program, and shall abide by all rules and policies within that program.

## **10. PHYSICAL PROTECTION**

- 10.1 Contractor shall provide proper protection for all new and existing Work, furnishings and fixtures subject to possible damage, and shall cover work-related exterior openings with insect-tight, dust-tight and water-tight protection at the end of each day's work.

- 10.2 Contractor shall protect finished surfaces, including jambs, sills and soffits of openings used as passageways or through which materials are handled, against possible damage resulting from conduct of work by trades. Tight wood sheeting shall be laid under all materials stored on finished surfaces. Planking shall be laid before moving materials over finished areas. Wheelbarrows used over such areas shall have rubber-tired wheels.
- 10.3 Finished surfaces, including factory-finished and job-finished items shall be clean and unmarred upon the turnover of the work to Wegmans. Without extra compensation, Contractor shall refinish or replace such surfaces where they are damaged.
- 10.4 Contractor shall protect finished floors from dirt and damage by covering as approved by the Wegmans. Contractor shall restore all existing surfaces damaged by Work under this Contract to a condition equal to or better than that existing at start of the Work.

## **11. SITE ENCLOSURES**

- 11.1 Except as otherwise specifically provided, Contractor shall provide secure temporary enclosures around all work areas and restricted access ways thereto to protect the safety of both personnel and property. Additionally, Contractor shall provide such fences, barricades and protective facilities as may be required for protection of personnel or the public in accordance with all applicable governmental regulations and as required to bar unauthorized personnel from hazardous areas. The location and design of all such facilities shall receive prior approval of Wegmans.

## **12. HAZARDOUS OR NOXIOUS WORK**

- 12.1 Contractor shall advise the Wegmans in writing and in advance of all plans for painting, blasting, pile driving, demolition of structures or other activities that may reasonably pose a danger or nuisance to the general public. Wegmans shall approve all schedules and methods proposed for such work before the start of the Work.

## **13. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS**

- 13.1 Contractor shall not be required to perform any work relating to the removal or the rendering harmless of hazardous materials, including but not limited to hazardous substances, chemicals, radioactive materials, hazardous waste, petroleum, asbestos or polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) encountered on the Project provided, that such hazardous materials were not introduced or released to the Project by Contractor or its agents, employees or Subcontractors or anyone under their direction or control.
- 13.2 In the event Contractor encounters on the Project material reasonably believed to be hazardous, Contractor shall immediately stop work in the area affected and report the condition to Wegmans in writing. The Work in the affected area shall be resumed in the absence of hazardous material, or when it has been rendered harmless, by written direction and representation of Wegmans. The Contract Time shall not be affected by any discovery of and subsequent work on, or removal of, any hazardous materials on the Project.
- 13.3 Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph 13.2, the Project Time shall be extended to the extent the Work is actually delayed by discovery of and subsequent work on, or removal of, any hazardous materials on the Project only if:
  - 13.3.1 Contractor demonstrates to the satisfaction of Wegmans that the Project Time will be actually and necessarily delayed;
  - 13.3.2 The effect of the cause of such delay cannot be avoided or mitigated by the exercise of all reasonable precautions, efforts and measures whether before or

after the occurrence or the cause of delay, including, but not limited to, redirecting work by Contractor to other physical locations on the job site; and

- 13.3.3 Contractor notifies Wegmans in writing within ten days after the time when Contractor knows or should know that the Project Time will be delayed for a reason contained within Subparagraph 10.8.3 identifying such reason and describing, as fully as practicable at that time, the nature and expected duration of the delay and its effect on the Project Time.
- 13.4 Any contamination with or presence of hazardous material at the site of the Project caused by Contractor which is unrelated to hazardous material discovered on the Project shall be promptly remedied by Contractor at no cost to Wegmans and with no delay to the Project. **Additional General Guidelines**
- 13.5 The identity of all Contractor employees and Subcontractor employees must be revealed to the Wegmans Facilities Manager prior to their appearance on Wegmans property. The Wegmans Facilities Manager will issue a roster of approved Contractor and Subcontractor employees to Wegmans Asset Protection prior to the commencement of the Work.
- 13.6 All Contractor and Subcontractor employees must sign in at the 400 Market Street Security Building as they arrive on the premises, and must sign out at the same location as they depart the premises. Each person will be issued a visitor badge, which must be in the immediate possession of the person at all times. Unless the conditions of performing the Work might dictate otherwise, this visitor badge is expected to be readily visible at all times. Visitor badges must be returned to the Security Building prior to the departure from the Wegmans Market Street Complex by the individual to whom the visitor badge was issued.
- 13.7 A Wegmans representative will greet and escort all first-time Contractor and Subcontractor employees to the appropriate location of their work, and will review the emergency evacuation points and gathering points as appropriate for the location of the Work.
- 13.8 All Contractor and Subcontractor employees must gain access to the interior of the buildings through only their use of designated entrances and exits.
  - 13.8.1 Each individual must "swipe" his own visitor badge when entering and exiting the building. Blocking an entry/exit door open, or holding the door open for another individual, or the use of any doorway for which a swipe card is not required for passage is prohibited unless prior approval has been received in writing from Wegmans Asset Protection.
  - 13.8.2 Where the Work is above the roof of a building and access to the roof is best afforded by using an exterior ladder or stair, the Contractor shall consult with representatives of Wegmans Asset Protection prior to commencing the Work and devise a mutually-agreeable method for monitoring and recording the movement of Contractor and Subcontractor employees.
- 13.9 Photographic equipment is prohibited from use on the property, except by Wegmans employees who are authorized for this purpose. The prohibition includes any picture-taking capabilities of cell phones.
- 14. **Food Safety Guidelines**
  - 14.1 All jewelry must be removed, including necklaces, rings, watches, bracelets, and any visible piercing. A plain wedding band (without stones) is allowed. Jewelry should be left in a vehicle prior to entering the facility.

- 14.2 Food or drink items, including mints, lifesavers, and chewing gum, are not permitted in the facility except in the designated cafeterias.
- 14.3 Inside the food processing areas, all hair must be covered by hairnets. Multiple hairnets may be necessary to cover longer hair. Beard/mustache net must be used if facial hair exceeds ½ inch.
- 14.4 Individuals with fake nails or nail polish will be required to wear food handler gloves.
- 14.5 Inside of the food processing areas, white lab coats must be worn in raw processing areas and blue lab coats must be worn in ready to eat areas. Boot or shoe covers must be worn.
- 14.6 Hands must be washed and sanitized upon entering all production areas.
- 14.7 Personal items such as handbags, backpacks, baseball caps, walkmans, or glass items are not permitted inside of or above the facility. Cellular telephones may be permitted, with prior written permission.
- 14.8 All equipment and or supplies shall be segregated from raw, in-process, food contact surfaces, or finished goods in such a manner to prevent cross-contamination.
- 14.9 Any work must completely prevent any and all contamination of the environment, production equipment, and product (ingredients or finished product). This prevention includes, but is not limited to, protection of the equipment or removal of equipment/product from the area. These measures must be approved by a Wegmans Production Manager, Maintenance Manager, or Quality Assurance Manager prior to performing any work.
- 14.10 Work in food manufacturing or food storage areas shall be performed when manufacturing or shipping/receiving is not in operation (unless otherwise approved by management).
- 14.11 Work areas must be kept reasonably clean at all times. At the end of each work shift, the Work area must be completely cleaned by the Contractor.
- 14.12 Any drilling into block walls, concrete roof decks, or similar must be done through grouting whenever possible. All drilled holes must be filled according to Design Services' specifications.
- 14.13 An allergen color-coding program is used in the facility. Buckets and brushes have a specific color code and cannot be used by contractors, service technicians or vendors inside/outside facility grounds. Contractor employees must review this program with management so that proper containers are used.
- 14.14 Tools and equipment such as scaffolds, lifts, and hoists must be clean before being used on the job site. The use of wood ladders is strictly prohibited. The use of Wegmans Food Markets equipment such as scissors lifts, man lifts, fork trucks, etc. is prohibited unless an emergency situation exists. Contractors and Subcontractors are required to provide their own equipment prior as required to execute the Work. In all cases where mechanized equipment such as lifts and trucks are to be used, a daily use permit must be obtained from the Facilities Manager or his/her designee.
- 14.15 Where footbaths or sanitizing sprayers are installed in Ready to Eat areas, Contractor employees must use them as instructed by Wegmans personnel.

15. **Human Safety Guidelines**



- 15.1 All contractors have total responsibility for the safety and health of their employees, and subcontractor employees, on the job site. They must comply with all applicable federal, state and local regulations and ensure that all employees have the appropriate level of training needed to perform their work activities.
  - 15.1.1 Slip resistant, steel toed boots are required.
  - 15.1.2 Smoking is prohibited in the facilities, and is permitted only in designated outdoor locations. Smoking above the roof is strictly prohibited..
  - 15.1.3 Overhead doors, strip doors and mechanized passage doors are to be used for movement of equipment or supplies only. Use of man doors is required when traveling throughout the facility.
  - 15.1.4 Contractors are required to supply all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to their employees working on site.
  - 15.1.5 All injuries, illnesses or spills shall be reported to Wegmans Loss Prevention at extension 3030 as soon as they are recognized. Daily injury/illness logs must be maintained by the Contractor and by Wegmans.
  - 15.1.6 All equipment and supplies shall be clear of fire exits, electrical panels or cabinets, stairways and be stored on pallets, cribbing or off floor/ground areas to encourage good housekeeping practices.
  - 15.1.7 Use of GFCI's shall be required for all extension cords used within the facility.
  - 15.1.8 Safety glasses are required in all areas where eye hazards of any type may exist.
- 15.2 Due to the heavy usage of motorized equipment throughout the facility by Wegmans personnel, special attention must be paid to your surroundings especially when rounding corners. Wegmans employees are highly skilled and trained in the operation of their equipment: do not disturb them while performing their duties or get too close to the equipment.
- 15.3 Contractors, Subcontractors, and their employees shall physically review the location of all relevant emergency exits with the management staff prior to commencing the Work.
- 15.4 In the event of an emergency, sirens will be heard and flashing strobe lights will be seen. The steps below must be followed to ensure your safety and security:
  - 15.4.1 Exit at the nearest available exit. Exit through pedestrian doors only. Do not walk under overhead doors, rapid doors or fire doors.
  - 15.4.2 Proceed to the evacuation point and wait for further instructions.
  - 15.4.3 For work activities above any building roof, refer to the specific Wegmans policies which direct that activity.
- 15.5 All Contractor employees must possess or have on-the-job access to a copy of all of their employer's safety programs. The Contractor's safety representative must conduct at least one (1) safety-oriented "toolbox talk" each calendar week during the execution of the Work. Attendance at these events shall be required for all Contractor and Subcontractor employees engaged in the Work, and a written record of the attendance and proceedings must be furnished to Wegmans representatives at the conclusion of the Work.
- 15.6 All Contractor employees must comply with their employer's and with Wegmans Food Markets' lockout/tagout, confined space entry, hot work permit, and similar procedures while working at the facility. Contractors must supply their own locks, tags, harnesses etc.
- 15.7 Equipment such as forklifts, pallet jacks, ladders, etc. must be in good working order and be operated by trained individuals only. Those individuals shall have on their possession a card specifying they have been trained on the appropriate equipment, and adhere to Wegmans manufacturing safety policy established for use of such equipment. Daily use permits are required. Overhead work permits are required whenever the Work is conducted above machinery, electrical distribution and similar panels or boxes, and similar property of Wegmans.

- 15.8 Contractor employees must obtain a Hot Work Permit prior to doing welding, torch cutting, or other high heat operations. Storage of propane tanks is strictly forbidden within the facility.
